Welcome to Rongevær Coastal Cabin (Rongevær Kysthytte)

Guests must familiarise themselves with the terms and conditions of use for Rongevær Coastal Cabin and are responsible for ensuring that these are complied with. The lead guest must be at least 20 years old. Please note that boats are available from **4.00 pm on the day of arrival** and must be returned to the landing stage on Baløy by no later than **3.00 pm on the day of departure**.



CANCELLATION


The Norwegian Trekking Association's (DNT's) general rules on cancellation also apply to Rongevær Coastal Cabin.

- Cancellations made up to five (5) days before the arrival date qualify for a full refund.
- There is no right to a refund for cancellations made later than five (5) days before the arrival date.

Bookings made online can be cancelled by logging in and going to My Page (Min Side) on the booking system. You can enter the booking system via the specific cabin on Ut.no. For bookings made by telephone/e-mail with the Bergen and Hordaland Trekking Association (larger groups), please contact <u>bht@dnt.no</u> for cancellations.

Practical information

- The facility is not locked.
- Please bring a sheet sleeping bag or your own bed set, as at other DNT cabins.
- All guests wash and clean up after themselves.
- Hot and cold water are supplied.
- Electric heating and wood-burning stove. Heating in the living rooms is regulated automatically and activated whenever there are guests at the facility.
- Washing equipment, detergent, toilet paper, paper towels and wood are provided at the facility.
- Guests have their own parking spaces on Baløy.
- Separate container for general waste on Baløy. Please take any glass, metal, empty bottles and special waste home.
- There are two landing stages at the facility and a barrel barbe Bring your own charcoal.
- Even if you have rented the entire facility, the boat landing stage and jetty facilities will not be closed to other guests. There may be day visitors and these are entitled to access the toilet in the Boathouse (Naustet).
- Please show consideration to other guests at the facility, other cabin guests and residents of the area.

The School House (Skulehuset)


- 3 storeys with 23 bed spaces divided into 4-person rooms, 5-person rooms and one 10-person room
- Fully-equipped kitchen with cups, plates, cutlery and serving dishes
- The kitchen also has a coffee maker, refrigerator and large household dishwasher. Follow the instructions for the dishwasher carefully. These are displayed in the kitchen
- Dining room and living room
- 2 bathrooms and 2 toilets
- Dogs not permitted

The Boathouse (Naustet)

- 14 bed spaces divided into 2-person rooms and one 4-person room
- The 4-person room is suitable for wheelchair users
- Three 2-person rooms, suitable for dogs
- 2 bathrooms with shower
- Kitchenette and small living room
- Common area on second floor available for use by all guests

Boats

- The boats are available at the pontoon on Baløy from
 4.00 pm on the day of arrival and must be returned to the pontoon on Baløy by no later than 3.00 pm on the day of departure.
- There are four 4-person rowing boats and four 5-person rowing boats, all of which are numbered. Please use the boat that you have booked and return it to the numbered berth on the pontoon after use.
- There are fixed oars in all boats. The boats have the option of two sets of oars, allowing two people to row simultaneously. Additional oars in the Boathouse at Rongevær.



- The rowing distance from Baløy to Rongevær Coastal Cabin is approximately 300 metres.
- We have life jackets for more people than there are places on the boats, but these are a mixture of jackets for children and adults, so please feel free to bring your own life jacket if you have one. Please return the life jacket after use.
- There are additional oars in the Boathouse at Rongevær.
- We do not have fishing gear nor any other equipment for water activities, so individuals will need to bring their own if required.
- All boats have a drain plug at the bottom. This must be screwed in before use to prevent water from entering. On returning the boat, the drain plug must be unscrewed again to prevent the boat from filling with rainwater.
- The use of boats is at your own risk.
- Show good sea sense! Do not overload the boats, and take into account the weather, wind, waves and other boat traffic.

Fire instructions

The lead guest must ensure that everyone staying in the cabin has been informed of the content of the fire instructions displayed. The cabin has its own fire alarm system. In the event of an alarm, the fire authorities will not be contacted. If the fire system is disconnected, a night duty arrangement must be established.

Let us know!

As the cabin is unattended, we would be grateful if you could notify us in the event of an absence or shortage of toilet paper, detergents, candles, matches, etc., or if there are any faults or deficiencies with the boats and life jackets.

Damage to cabin, boats and fixtures/fittings

Damage or deficiencies are to be reported to the cabin operations manager at the Bergen and Hordaland Trekking Association on tel. +47 55 33 58 10, e-mail: <u>bht@dnt.no</u>. Any person causing damage may be held liable for it.

On departure

- ✓ Clean all rooms that have been used, the kitchen, toilets and showers.
- \checkmark Clean and empty barbecues of charcoal if these have been used.
- ✓ Remains of food must *not* be left behind.
- ✓ Empty all waste bins and insert new bin liners. Take all waste to the container on Baløy.
- ✓ Moor the boat securely.
- ✓ Return the life jacket.
- ✓ Leave the cabin as you would wish to find it!
